The MENPS Colour Run is a school fundraiser – a chance to raise vital funds for MENPS whilst our kids have heaps of fun!!

What and Why... Donate to encourage kids' participation in colourful outdoor fun! The Colour Run is not a competition. Kids run / walk through obstacles while volunteers throw colour powders on them - all in a good cause to support our school's funding goals for new outdoor play equipment!

Is it safe? Colour powders are made of natural ingredients like maize starch and vegetable colours. It is non-toxic and specially formulated to be fire resistant. It is safe on human bodies; however we suggest people with allergies, asthma, or eczema etc. keep at the spectators' area to minimise risks; OR if you are super keen, wear a mask. Runners can wear sunglasses or goggles for extra safety.

What about clothing? Colours don't stain under normal circumstances although might leave a light coloured wash on the item of clothing. You can wear old or disposable clothing if you do NOT intend to save the colours in your clothing. If you want to save the coloured clothing, refer to below the 'More questions' link for step-by-step instructions.

Can Whānau come? The more the merrier! Parents / caregivers are most welcome to

participate as spectators and cheer up the runners. We will need volunteers to set up courses, and throw powders at runners during the event. We will have 7 colour stations with red, yellow, green, pink, purple, orange.

So you're signed up and your fundraising page has been shared on the family group chat. You're ready for the most colourful day 2024! Here are some details about how the event will run:

Date Friday 22 March 2024 in the field from 1:30 to 3 pm Senior school will complete the course first, followed by junior students.

What to wear Theme: Crazy Costume Colour!

Non-uniform day - students will be encouraged to wear old clothes, a white T-shirt, bring a towel for the car and change of clothes. Goggles/sunglasses for the run would be a good idea.

Students can run in bare feet and are encouraged to dress up. Dress up with colourful tutus, wigs, hats, sunglasses.

The PTA second hand shop has some white polos for sale on the morning of the event.

Heaps of fun spot prizes to be won when you sign up to a profile, and the 5 classrooms who raise the most funds will win a PIE LUNCH thanks to Big Ben Pies!

Fundraising challenge! If the fundraising reaches \$15,000 Associate Principal Hilary Edwards will run the course. If we can get up to \$30,000 Principal Alan Jackson will run the course in a costume!!!
